


Guideline for physical admission to PG seats 2020-21

Guidelines are issued to PG candidates who are taking admission to PG seat 2020-21 at Vijayanagar Institute of Medical Sciences (VIMS), Bellary. These are combined guidelines of MCC, Govt. of India and Govt. of Karnataka. Following directions are issued under Section 24(1) of the Disaster Management Act 2005 and section 2(1) of the Epidemic Disease Act 1897 to regulate movement of persons from other states to Karnataka in portal modification of the order number RD 158 TNR 2020 (P1) issued on 03.06.2020.

1. Both 1st round (non-upgraded) and 2nd round candidates should report physically to the college for completion of admission within the last date. Failing to do so the admission given is deemed to be cancelled.
2. All candidates who are taking admission through physical verification should come prepared to **stay back** and join duty after the quarantine period.
3. All candidates should compulsorily get evaluated at VIMS, Bellary in **fever clinic** before proceeding to the admission desk. Failing to do so admission will not be granted.
4. All the out of city candidates should follow the quarantine norms issued from time to time by the state and district administration.
5. College will give their choice of institutional quarantine, if the candidate is not interested to stay in such of the institutional quarantine facility, he/she can choose to stay on payment basis.
6. Candidates will be shifted to the concerned hostels only after the completion of quarantine stay.
7. All candidates should have registered on Arogyasethu AAP, govt of India MOHFW. They should compulsorily wear mask during admission.
8. Admission process will be functioning in the Auditorium near OPD, Land mark is opposite to Nandini Parlor near OPD.

Quarantine norms (As per Govt. of Karnataka):

- a. Person coming from Maharashtra shall be placed in 7 days institutional quarantine followed by 7 days home quarantine.
- b. Person coming from Delhi or Tamilnadu shall be placed in 3 days institutional quarantine followed by 11 days home quarantine
- c. Person coming states other than Maharashtra, Delhi and Tamilnadu shall be placed in 14 days home quarantine.

- b. All transport companies such as airlines railways and road transport companies are required to ensure that their passengers have done the registration on sevasindhu portal for the relevant mode of transport before boarding the flight, train, or bus.

Any violation of the quarantine norms or failure to registration on sevasindhu portal or giving of incorrect information by the incoming persons are carrying of passengers by the transport companies with registration on the portal shall attract penal as per section 51(b) of the National Disaster Management act 2005 and section 188 of the Indian penal code.
